2023 Western US Oireachtas



This past November the Regional Championships were held in Phoenix, Arizona and the McKeever School sent 36 dancers to represent the team. The competed in traditional set dance solos, Championship solos (to qualify for the Worlds), Adult Championships and Team or Ceili competitions! Dancers from 13 different States gather together each November for this event as part of the Western USA Oireachtas or Regional Qualifying Championships. Next Year's championship will also be in Phoenix!



2023 Western US Oireachtas

The week before Thanksgiving the McKeever Team descended upon Phoenix and competed against dancers from 13 states over 3 days. Day one we had 11 champs compete and looking their absolute best. Our 3 open champs recalling making the top of their groups. Sophia Teves (21st) and Olive Kincaid (22nd) qualifying for Nationals and Ruby Kincaid (7th) and qualifying for Worlds for the first time in her career!!!! We are so proud of everyone! Ruby will travel to Glasgow, Scotland the week before Easter and compete against dancers from across the globe at the Oireachtas Rince Na Cruinne or World Irish Dance Championships. On day two of the Oireachtas we had all our teams and traditional set soloists compete. It's a huge deal to put in all that work and go up there on stage. A special shout out to our U8 team coming in 4th overall!! Outstanding! To top it off all four girls placed in their solos as well! Kiana 22nd, Alina 20th, Ella 7th and Emilia 6th!!!! This Oireachtas was extra special because this was Miss Natalie's first Oireachtas as a TCRG or official certified Irish Dance teacher! Day three of the Oireachtas was a success with seven champs competing and pulling off their absolute best on stage. Congratulations to Morgan, Dahlia, Millie, Hannah, Chloe, Emelina, and Rory who represented the team that day. We saw you give your absolute biggest effort up there! Huge congratulations to Morgan and Rory on their recalls and Nationals Qualifications! Morgan coming in 25th out of an insane group and Rory 12th in another talented competition. Both are qualified for the North American Championships in Texas!

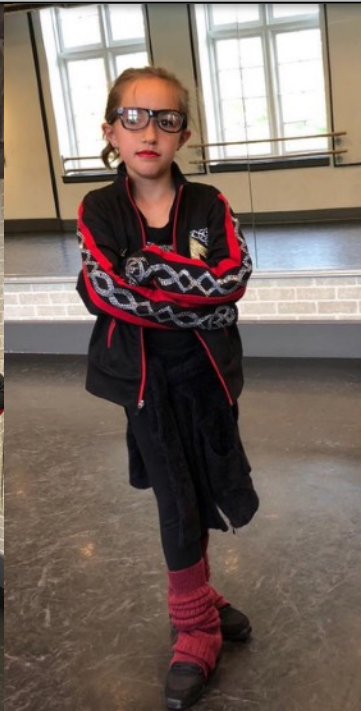
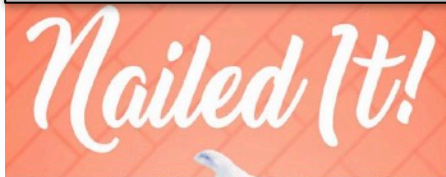

Irishpalooza 2024 at Harlow's


